

## Challenges Opportunities Overview Asbestos (regulations, good and bad Regulatory framework not clear and very Audits, samples, reports,... engineering and knowledge work practices, experiences,...) is the reference complex Almost no entrance barriers, any operator Also done in rehabilitation and other phases First generation companies/departments can start a company overnight of the building Big differences between companies: For many types of hazardous substances, Large number of substances becoming departments of demolition or newly created lack of knowledge and information hazardous in the coming years Companies perceived as problem-solvers Strong price competition (mainly asbestos) Regulations not always enforced due to the lack of knowledge available/fear Technical value of the operation must be Increasing importance of consultants in proved by someone else large projects Liabilities and high level of responsibility
